

GDPR for Clients

At the Dharma Clinic we collect and store client information in a number of ways:

- When you register online for any of our services
- At the time of booking an appointment
- Client forms
- Client consultations

Your data will only be used for the purpose of treatment, classes or counselling. We will only share information with other health professionals with your permission and agree not to divulge this information to any other third party without your agreement.

If you agree to accept marketing emails from us you may always opt out at a later date.

The nature of our business is to provide therapies for your wellbeing. All records must therefore be kept for a period of 7 years from the date of the last treatment/class. Your records will be kept confidential. All our staff must sign a confidentiality agreement to protect your privacy.

Right to access: You have the right to request a copy of the personal information we keep on you. There may be a small charge for this service.

Right to rectification: You have the right to request that any information you believe to be in-accurate is amended.

Right to removal of data: You have the right to request that we delete your records; we legally have to keep information regarding your treatment, classes or therapies for 7 years from the date of last appointment/class. We can remove your e-mail from our database at any time.

Right to data portability: You have the right to request we copy the information to other organisations. A signed consent form from yourself or guardian would be required.
